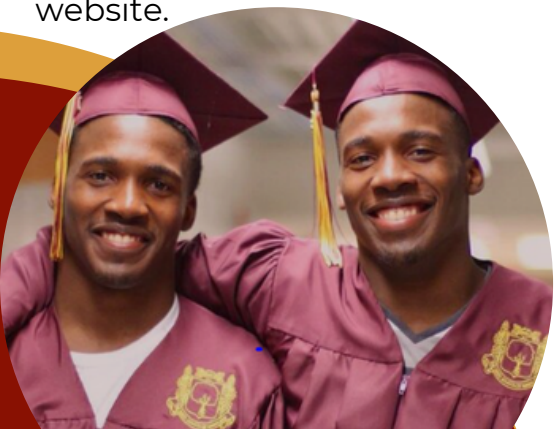


Statement of Plan

Title I Program

Once a year, our Family Engagement Team facilitates a Title I meeting in the fall that provides information about the Title I program, familial rights, and the role you play in your child's education. If you are not able to attend the Annual Title I Meeting, information can be found on The SEED School Maryland's website or provided via live streaming in the private SEED MD parent Facebook group.

Topics Shared at the Annual Meeting include:

- Explanation of the Title I program to families
- Inform families of their rights to be involved in the decision-making process as partners in their child's education
- Inform parents of their right to request information about the qualifications of the child(ren)'s teachers
- Review the Title I budget & receive parent feedback on what events & programs they would like to see during the year.
- Review and revise the Title I Family Engagement Plan & Home-School Compact
- Explain local and state academic assessments

PowerSchool

PowerSchool is an online system in which student demographics, grade point averages, class schedules, report cards, progress reports, etc. are tracked. In addition, parent-guardians are able to monitor their scholar's academic progress, as well.

The SEED School of Maryland also utilizes PowerSchool to send mass communication to families via email and automated calls.
